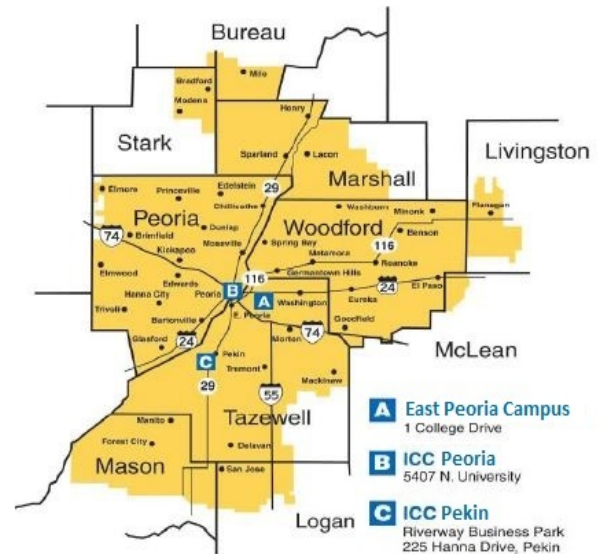


# Illinois Central College Essentials, Fall 2018

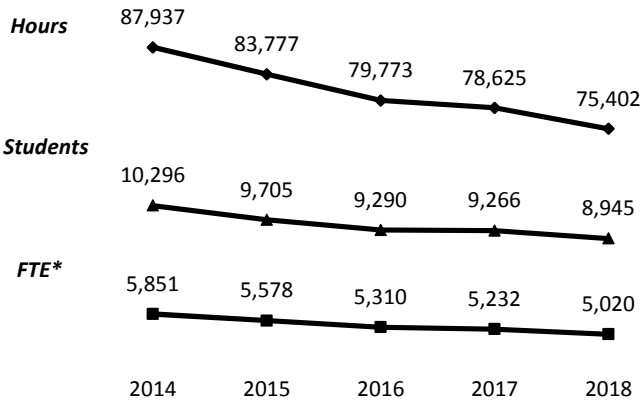

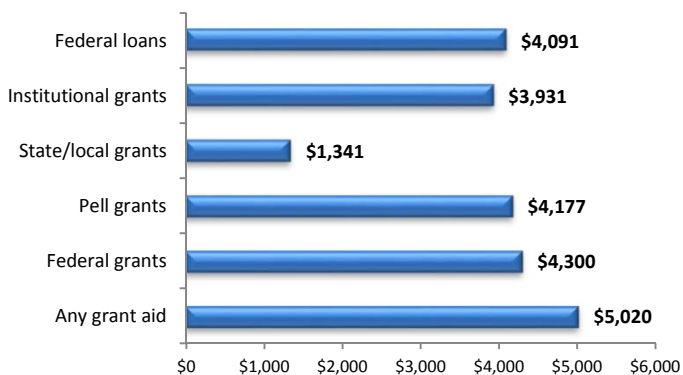

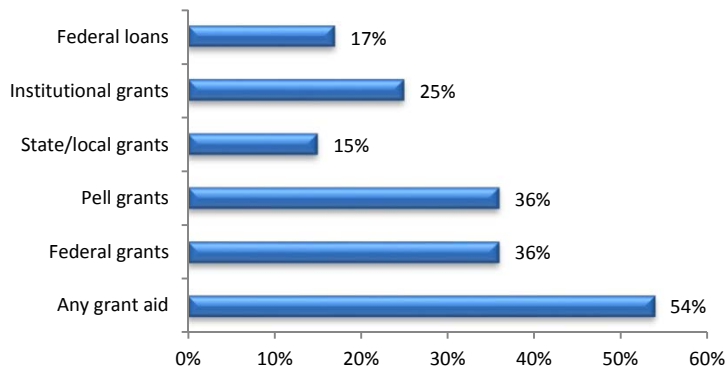
