3. Answer all questions honestly and accurately. Use your full legal name in filling out this application and include all other last names you may have used over the years.
4. Emergency contact information will remain confidential and will be used by ICC Campus Police personnel only in the event you attend ICC and there is an emergency that requires contact.
5. Questions requiring you to respond about your ethnicity and race are required by the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) and the Federal government. Information provided in these questions will be kept confidential and used for state and federally mandated recordkeeping. The country of origin question is requested for the Illinois Shared Enrollment and Graduation (ISEG) project. Definitions (according to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System):
 - a. Asian – you have origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent, including, for example: Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.
 - b. American Indian or Alaska Native – you have origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) and you maintain tribal affiliation or community attachment.
 - c. Black or African American – you have origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
 - d. Hispanic or Latino – you are of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.
 - e. White – you have origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.
 - f. Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander – you have origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

The **ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE** focuses on the arts, humanities, social or behavioral sciences, or one of the professional fields with these disciplines as a base. Students must complete at least 60 credit hours of transfer credit courses. Completion time usually takes about two years of full-time enrollment.

The **ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE DEGREE** focuses on baccalaureate degree programs in one of the mathematical, biological, physical science fields or one of the professional fields with these disciplines as a base. Students must complete at least 60 credit hours of transfer credit courses. Completion time usually takes about two years of full-time enrollment.

The **ASSOCIATE IN ENGINEERING SCIENCE DEGREE** is designed for individuals interested in transferring to a bachelor degree program in engineering. Students must complete at least 60 credit hours of transfer credit courses. Completion time usually takes about two years of full-time enrollment.

The **ASSOCIATE IN APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREE** is designed for students interested in preparing for employment upon completion of the degree. The number of semester hours varies by program. Credit hours earned toward this degree typically are not transferable to four-year colleges and universities. Some programs, however, do support transfer. Students should discuss transfer options for these programs with their program advisor.

The **ASSOCIATE IN GENERAL STUDIES DEGREE** is designed for individuals interested in acquiring a general education to suit specific needs, usually for self-improvement. It is not designed as a transfer degree. The General Education Degree requires a minimum of 60 credit hours of college level coursework. It should not be confused with the high school equivalency degree known as the GED® (General Education Development diploma).

A **CERTIFICATE** requires less than two years of study in preparation for employment.
