## ESTIMATED EXPENSES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The estimated expenses shown below are for international students planning to attend Illinois Central College. Actual figures for living expenses will vary depending on housing arrangements, personal meal habits, etc. However, in order to receive an I-20 to secure a student (F-1) visa to attend ICC, the amount shown below must be verified for the length of your program of study. Students living in campus housing are eligible for tuition assessed at the in-state rate of \$150 per credit hour, and students living off campus are assessed at the out of country rate of \$367 per credit hour.
