

Western Illinois University (WIU) students are not required to have foreign language to be admitted to Western. Western **does require** that students, **prior to graduation** from WIU, complete a global issues component, which can be accomplished several ways.

Students can meet the Global Issues graduation requirement by completing

- A general education class designated at Global Issues
- A 300-level course (major or non-major) designated as Global Issues
- 3 years of one language in high school with an average grade of C or better

Students can use courses completed at a Illinois Central community college to satisfy the Global Issues requirement.
