

International Student Admissions



Thank you for your interest in Illinois Central College. Following are the admissions requirements for individuals wishing to secure a student visa to attend Illinois Central College. These requirements conform to the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement regulations governing issuance of student visas.

The admission process includes the following steps:

- 1) Complete the Illinois Central College Admissions Application.
- 2) Complete the International Student Information Sheet.
- 3) Provide official high school (and college, if applicable) transcripts, with full English translation. If you have international college credit you'd like to have ICC consider as transfer credit, you must have your transcript evaluated through World Education Services . (www.wes.org).
- 4) Request that your TOEFL score report be sent directly to Illinois Central College, using our Institutional TOEFL code, 1312. A minimum score of 500/paper-based or 173/computer-based, 59 IBT, is required for admittance. (For testing locations visit www.toefl.org).
- 5) Have your financial sponsor complete the affidavit of Sponsor form promising support in the amount of \$19, 010 per year, the amount necessary to cover your education and living expenses. (See page 2 for breakdown of expenses.)
- 6) Have your financial sponsor provide the following documents:
 - a. A current official bank account history, showing account activity (debits & credits) for the period of three consecutive months. These statements must be translated into English, must be signed by a bank official, and bear the seal of the financial institution.
 - b. A letter from his/her employer, on company letterhead, stating length of employment and annual salary.
