## Psychology

The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology at Western Illinois University (WIU).

Students intending to complete a Bachelor of Science (B.S) degree in Psychology from WIU should follow the Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree program outlined in this handout from Illinois Central College (ICC).

Students who complete the A.A. degree at Illinois Central College may transfer to WIU and complete their B.S. degree in Psychology in an additional two years.
