## Notes

- Apply to Eastern and have official transcripts sent from high school and college
- Courses taken at a community college will not be used toward upper division requirements. 40 semester hours of upper division credit is required for a Bachelor's Degree. These courses are to be taken at the senior level institution.
- Foreign Language is a graduation requirement. Two full years of high school foreign language with a "C" average or completion of the second semester of a college foreign language will satisfy this requirement.

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<sup>1</sup> A "C" or better is required in English, Speech, Math (Algebra or higher) and all courses for the major.

<sup>2</sup> Apply to Eastern and have official transcripts sent from high school and college.

<sup>3</sup> Either the Physical Science or the Life Science class must have a lab component. A total of 7 hours in sciences is required.

<sup>4</sup> A U.S. Government or Constitution course is required for teacher certification. POLSC 115 is recommended.

<sup>5</sup> Transfer students with 29 or fewer hours must complete MUS 1103 (5) times; 30-59 transfer hours must complete MUS 1103 (4) times; 60 or more transfer hours must complete MUS 1103 (3) times.

<sup>6</sup> Completion of the Advanced Study Jury is required in order to complete the Junior Recital.
